RAKMHSU's Bachelor of Pharmacy (B Pharm) program comprises of six months of general education, one year of basic sciences, two-and-a-half years of pharmaceutical sciences and training, and six months of Practice School. The total program duration is four-and-a-half years.

Basic and pharmaceutical sciences are integrated, and the curriculum prepares them for evidence-based pharmacy practice in today's changing health care environment. Student life and campus facilities

RAKMHSU is located in a self-sufficient campus next to Saqr Hospital and RAK Hospital. Set in the quiet and serene Al Qusaidat neighbourhood in Ras Al Khaimah, the new campus has state-of-the-art lecture halls, a well-stacked central library, well-equipped nursing skills laboratories, IT resources and computer services. An added attraction is the large, hi-tech large auditorium with theatre-type seating; hence ideal for regular conferences, CME Programs, seminars, teleconferencing and so on. In addition, there are recreational and sports facilities for male and female students, cafeteria and prayer halls. Academic counselling and Student Visas are also provided by the University.

How to get in - admission criteria

UAE NGSSE:

Aggregate of 70% in Physics, Chemistry and Biology in 12th Grade with minimum of 60% in Physics, Chemistry and Biology individually.

Pakistan Boards/Certificates:

Higher Secondary School Certificate with aggregate of 65% in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Part 1 and Part 2 total) with a minimum of 60% in each of these courses.

Indian Boards/Certificates:

CBSE XII Std with 65% aggregate in Physics, Chemistry & Biology with at least 60% in each of these courses.

For Indian State Board Examination 70% aggregate in Physics, Chemistry & Biology with at least 60% in each of these courses is required.

For other curriculum, equivalencies corresponding to UAE NGSSE apply.

Meritorious students get special scholarships

15% concession in the tuition fee is provided for all students securing above 90% in aggregate of Physics, Chemistry and Biology in 12th grade/UAE NGSSE/equivalent and up to 20% of tuition fee is provided for those scoring above 95%. This concession is limited to the first semester only.

A student who secures a GPA of 3.75 or above on a 4.0 scale in any semester of the program shall be entitled for a concession of 20% in the tuition fee for the next semester.

Full scholarship in tuition fee is provided to suitable UAE National students who have secured high scores in UAE NGSSE/12th grade by Sheikh Saqr Program for Government Excellence (Government of RAK).

Fees above are applicable for the academic year 2010–2011. Fees are payable semester-wise, prior to commencement of the semester.

Late registration fee: AED 500 if fees are not paid latest by the first day of the new semester.

Exam fee: AED 200 per course, per semester. It varies slightly from semester to semester depending on the number of courses. Example: If there are 5 courses in a semester, 5x200 or AED 1000 per semester.

Health Insurance card is mandatory. RN-BSN Bridge Program students should have a valid Health Insurance card from the government or should be adequately covered under health insurance by a current employer.

Lab Caution Deposit, a one-time payment, will be refunded on leaving the institution subject to no damage or loss to items/property.

Students will be required to buy instruments and personal protective gear including uniforms, masks, gloves etc as required.

Student Residence Facility: The Government of RAK has built state-of-the-art student residence facilities in the American University of Ras Al Khaimah (AURAK) Campus for students pursuing higher education in institutions in Ras Al Khaimah including RAKMHSU. Refund Policy

Refund requests should be made at the Office of Registration through a written request enclosing ID card and original fee receipt. Refund will be made only after clearance of dues, if any. The refund policy applies to all semesters. On approval of the refund claim, the amount shall be refunded as mentioned below.

Refund of Tuition Fee

Refund Request Time	Amount Eligible for Refund
Any time after admission, before orientation/commencement of classes	Tuition fee paid will be refundable after deducting AED 2,000.
Within 15 days from orientation/commencement of classes	50% of tuition fee for the semester will be refunded.
After 15 days from student orientation/commencement of classes	No refund.

Note: Students who do not report for orientation, registration and classes for any reason should submit fee refund claim within 15 days from the date of orientation. No refunds will be entertained later.

Refund of Transport Fee: Students not availing transport within two weeks of commencement of classes will be refunded 50% of the transport fee. Beyond two weeks, the fee paid is non-refundable.
